

## Historic Preservation Commission FY2025 Goals

**HPC Mission Statement:** To preserve, protect, and promote the City of Round Rock's historical resources through preservation, public education, heritage tourism, and community partnerships.

- 1. Support *Round Rock 2030's* adopted historic preservation policies.
- 2. HPC involvement with downtown mixed-used zoning project.
  - Learn more about downtown mixed-used zoning project by attending relevant meetings and open houses.
  - Reach out to property owners of non-designated historic properties downtown regarding potential historic designation.
- 3. Support the City Council's strategic plan goal regarding Old Town.
  - Consider developing a historic walking guide for Old Town, potentially utilizing QR codes instead of printed guides. To be completed after construction
- 4. Continue to monitor the restoration of the Palm House. Review restoration plan and issue Certificate of Appropriateness for relevant aspects.
- 5. Consider a future restoration plan for the Sansom House.
- 6. Work with City departments to create a summary of heritage tourism goals.
- 7. Create a video on "what does preservation mean to you" to promote to the public what preservation is, why its valuable, and how to get young people involved.
- 8. Review October 2024 Indigenous Peoples Day proclamation language and contact primary sources for input on future Indigenous Peoples Day proclamation language.
- 9. Continue to partner with Round Rock Preservation.
- 10. Collaborate and communicate with the Williamson Museum about projects, programs, and attend their events. Coordinate on museum exhibits and Stagecoach Inn event.
- 11. Become more involved in the promotion of the Local Legends program:
  - HPC should be proactive in reaching out to organizations with a historical connection.
  - Each Commissioner to solicit one new nomination for the 2025 Legends.
  - Communications & Preservation staff complete a Local Legends promotional video.
- 12. Promote National Preservation Month
- 13. Complete the local marker installation process
- 14. Complete the FY2025 Tax Exemption Program.
- 15. Each commissioner to attend at least one preservation training per year.
