

RESOLUTION NO. R-2018-5643

WHEREAS, Chapter 43, Code of Ordinances (2010 Edition), designates certain trees in the City as Monarch Trees, and

WHEREAS, Monarch Trees are protected and may not be removed unless the monarch designation is removed by the City Council, and

WHEREAS, Cunningham|Allen, Inc. has submitted a request on behalf of developer CalAtlantic Homes (Lennar) to remove the monarch designation for two trees located on the site of the proposed Reserve at Wyoming Springs single-family subdivision, and

WHEREAS, the two Monarch Trees requested for removal are shown on Exhibit “A” as tree numbers 403 and 456, Now Therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROUND ROCK, TEXAS,

That the monarch designations for the two Monarch Trees numbered 403 and 456 located on the site of the proposed Reserve at Wyoming Springs development as shown on Exhibit “A”, are hereby removed.

The City Council hereby finds and declares that written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted was posted and that such meeting was open to the public as required by law at all times during which this Resolution and the subject matter hereof were discussed, considered and formally acted upon, all as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended.
