

Sec. 4-2. - Sale of alcoholic beverages within 300 feet of a church, public school, or public hospital prohibited.

- (a) The measurement of the distance between the place of business where alcoholic beverages are sold and the church or public hospital shall be along the property lines of the street fronts and from front door to front door, and in a direct line across intersections.
- (b) The measurement of the distance between the place of business where alcoholic beverages are sold and the public school shall be:
 - (1) In a direct line from the property line of the public school to the property line of the place of business, and in a direct line across intersections; or
 - (2) If the permit of license holder is located on or above the fifth story of a multistory building, in a direct line from the property line of the public or private school to the property line of the place of business, in a direct line across intersections, and vertically up the building at the property line to the base of the floor on which the permit or license holder is located.
- (c) Except as provided in subsection (d) of this section, the sale of alcoholic beverages within 300 feet of a church, public school, or public hospital as determined by measurements prescribed in this section is prohibited.
- (d) Where the church, public school, or public hospital is located within a commercial zoning district, no separation from places of business where alcoholic beverages are sold shall be required.
