

RESOLUTION NO. R-2020-0218

WHEREAS, Zoning and Development Code, Chapter 4, Article VI, Section 4-80 Code of Ordinances (2018 Edition) provides that under certain conditions the City will furnish water and wastewater services outside of the city limits; and

WHEREAS, Williamson County Emergency Services District No. 3, the owner of record of the property at Lot 1, Block A, Siena Section 35, a subdivision of Williamson County, Texas, as shown in Exhibit “A” (“Property”), has requested that the City furnish wastewater service to said Property; and

WHEREAS, the Council hereby determines that the City has adequate capacity of wastewater service available for the purpose of serving the Property without impairing services within the City; and

WHEREAS, the owners of the Property must comply with all of the provisions of §4-80 with respect to costs, construction standards, inspections, *et cetera*; and

WHEREAS, the owners of the Property must also comply with applicable subdivision and platting statutes and ordinances, Now Therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROUND ROCK, TEXAS,

That subject to owners compliance with applicable subdivision and platting statutes and ordinances, and pursuant to Zoning and Development Code, Chapter 4, Article VI, Section 4-80 Code of Ordinances (2018 Edition) the City Council hereby approves the furnishing of wastewater service to the Property, subject to the owners compliance with the requirements of said §4-80, at the rates specified in §4-80(b) of the Code, and in accordance with the Out-of-City Wastewater Service Agreement described below, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,

That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City an Out-of-City Wastewater Service Agreement with Williamson County Emergency Services District No. 3, a copy of said agreement being attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and incorporated herein for all purposes.

The City Council hereby finds and declares that written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted was posted and that such meeting was open to the public as required by law at all times during which this Resolution and the subject matter hereof were discussed, considered and formally acted upon, all as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended.
