**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROUND ROCK, TEXAS ADOPTING THE CITY OF
ROUND ROCK HAZARD MITIGATION ACTION PLAN UPDATE: 2025 UPDATE
MITIGATING RISK FOR A SAFE, SECURE, SUSTAINABLE FUTURE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Round Rock (“City”) recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously adopted a FEMA-approved Hazard Mitigation Action Plan and wishes to approve a new updated plan; and

WHEREAS, the City has prepared an updated multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as City of Round Rock Hazard Mitigation Action Plan Update: 2025 Update Mitigating Risk for a Safe, Secure, Sustainable Future (“Plan”), in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the City from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the Plan and adoption by City Council demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to approve and implement the new Plan, Now Therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROUND ROCK, TEXAS,

That the City Council adopts the City of Round Rock Hazard Mitigation Action Plan Update: 2025 Update Mitigating for a Safe, Secure, Sustainable Future, attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

This Plan, as approved, may be edited or amended after submission for review, but will not require the City Council to re-adopt any further iterations. This only applies to this specific Plan and does not absolve the City from updating the Plan in five (5) years.

The City Council hereby finds and declares that written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted was posted and that such meeting was open to the

public as required by law at all times during which this Resolution and the subject matter hereof were discussed, considered and formally acted upon, all as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended.
