**WHEREAS**, the City of Round Rock, Texas (the "City") is a participating and founding member of the Brushy Creek Regional Utility Authority, Inc., (the "BCRUA"); and

**WHEREAS**, the BCRUA retained engineering services with Walker Partners/Freese and Nichols Joint Venture for the BCRUA Phase 2 Raw Water Delivery System Project; and

**WHEREAS**, Walker Partners/Freese and Nichols Joint Venture has submitted Supplemental Contract No. 11 to the Contract to modify the provisions for the scope of services and to increase the compensation by \$745,999.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to authorize the BCRUA to enter into said supplemental contract with Walker Partners/Freese and Nichols Joint Venture, Now Therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROUND ROCK, TEXAS,**

That the City Council hereby authorizes the Brushy Creek Regional Utility Authority to enter into Supplemental Contract No. 11 with Walker Partners/Freese and Nichols Joint Venture for the BCRUA Phase 2 Raw Water Delivery System Project, a copy of said contract being attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein for all purposes.
