ORDINANCE NO. O-2023-414

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 24, ARTICLE II, CODE OF ORDINANCES (2018 EDITION), CITY OF ROUND ROCK, TEXAS, REGARDING A YOUTH CURFEW; AND PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE AND REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS.

WHEREAS, the City of Round Rock, Texas previously enacted provisions in its Code of Ordinances relating to juvenile curfew hours; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 370 of the Local Government Code now prohibits a political subdivision from enforcing juvenile curfews, except for purposes of emergency management; Now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROUND ROCK, TEXAS:

I.

That Chapter 24, Article II, Code of Ordinances (2018 Edition), City of Round Rock, Texas, is hereby repealed in its entirety. The effective date of this repeal is immediate.

II.

A. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, or resolutions in conflict herewith are expressly repealed.

B. The invalidity of any section or provision of this ordinance shall not invalidate other sections or provisions thereof.

C. The City Council hereby finds and declares that written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of the meeting at which this Ordinance was adopted was posted and that such meeting was open to the public as required by law at all times during

1 which this Ordinance and the subject matter hereof were discussed, considered and
2 formally acted upon, all as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas
3 Government Code, as amended.

6 Council members present, the requirement for reading this ordinance on two separate
7 days was dispensed with.
