11	Code of Ordinances relating to juvenile curfew hours; and
12	WHEREAS, Chapter 370 of the Local Government Code now prohibits a political
13	subdivision from enforcing juvenile curfews, except for purposes of emergency
14	management; Now therefore,
15 16	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROUND ROCK,
17	TEXAS:

19	That Chapter 24, Article II, Code of Ordinances (2018 Edition), City of Round
20	Rock, Texas, is hereby repealed in its entirety. The effective date of this repeal is
21	immediate.

23 24	A. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, or resolutions in conflict herewith are
25	expressly repealed.
26	B. The invalidity of any section or provision of this ordinance shall not
27	invalidate other sections or provisions thereof.
28	C. The City Council hereby finds and declares that written notice of the date,
29	hour, place and subject of the meeting at which this Ordinance was adopted was posted

and that such meeting was open to the public as required by law at all times during
