#### ARTICLE A.1 GUARANTEED MAXIMUM PRICE

#### § A.1.1 Guaranteed Maximum Price

Pursuant to Section 3.2.6 of the Agreement, the Owner and Construction Manager hereby amend the Agreement to establish a Guaranteed Maximum Price. As agreed by the Owner and Construction Manager, the Guaranteed Maximum Price is an amount that the Contract Sum shall not exceed. The Contract Sum consists of the Construction Manager's Fee plus the Cost of the Work, as that term is defined in Article 6 of the Agreement.

§ A.1.1.1 The Contract Sum is guaranteed by the Construction Manager not to exceed Thirteen Million Four Hundred Ninety-Four Thousand Two Hundred Sixty Dollars and No Cents (\$ 13,494,260.00 ), subject to additions and deductions by Change Order as provided in the Contract Documents.

Package 2 - Lakeview is the construction of the new stage, pavilion, and restroom. This includes demo of existing structures and site, earthwork, site utilities, concrete flatwork, retaining walls, food truck infrastructure, playground, fishing dock, structures, and landscaping.

#### **Overview**

The new Lakeview package demo's out the existing waterfront area and builds it out. This work is planned to be completed in one main package:

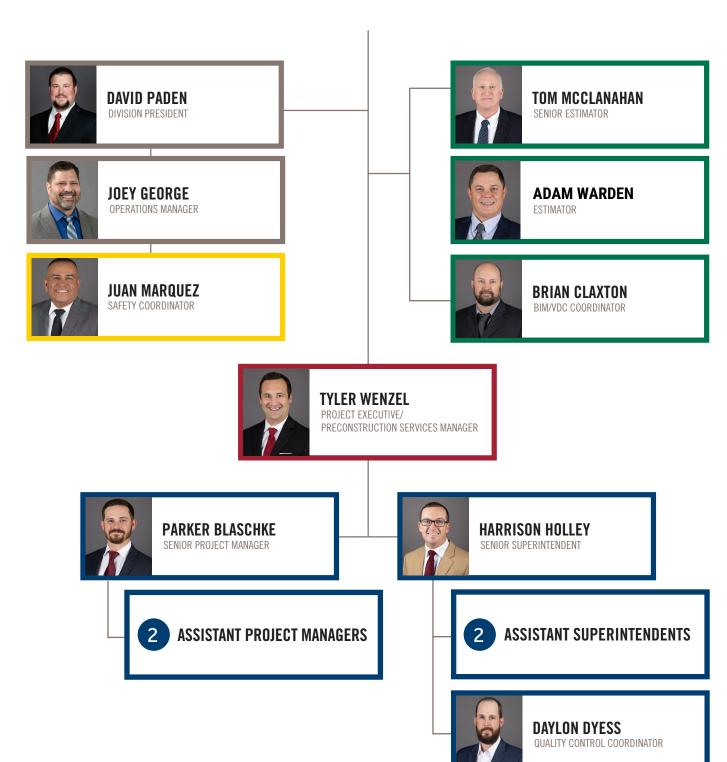

#### **GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS**

- 1. Waeltz & Prete, Inc. is the civil engineer/prime consultant of record.
- 2. Mode Design Company is the architect of record.
- 3. Ecoland Design Group is the landscape architect of record.
- 4. KSS Engineers is the structural engineer of record.
- 5. Bacorn Bros, LLC is the MEP engineer of record.
- 6. Architectural, Civil and Structural specification manual was provided to SpawGlass.
- 7. MEP specifications were not provided other than general notes in the 90% CD Drawings.
- 8. Based on an anticipated NTP of October 2024.
- 9. The baseline schedule is based on a 5-day work week.
- 10. Normal working hours have been included from 7:00 AM to 5:30 PM unless otherwise noted, with exception to early concrete operations as deemed necessary. It is also assumed that work can occur on a 7 day a week schedule if required. SpawGlass to coordinate weekend work with owner special events and inspections.
- 11. In order to subcontract scopes of work in a timely manner to meet the construction schedule it is assumed that buyout packages will be reviewed within 5 business days of their submission.
- 12. LEED Certifications or Green Building Programs are not incorporated into the project.
- 13. Builders Risk Insurance is provided by SpawGlass. Builder's Risk deductible to be paid from construction contingency.
- 14. Performance & Payment Bonds are provided by SpawGlass.
- 15. General Liability is provided by SpawGlass and carried by each individual subcontractor.
- 16. Proposal assumes that the specified material and equipment are available as required to meet the schedule. If they are not available as required, we assume the Owner/Architect will authorize alternate material or equipment selections.
- 17. Owner must accept GMP within 60 calendar days, at which time pricing will expire.
- 18. General conditions were originally based on one overall project and GMP during the RFP/RFQ time, and not 6.51% as later outlined by the City. Any general conditions savings or losses from this package are to be rolled into the other GMP packages.
- 19. Assumes No Asbestos Containing Material Onsite, City of Round Rock to provide Environmental Survey prior to demolition start.
- 20. Reference Alternate Spreadsheet for alternates not included in base proposal.





#### **SPECIFIC QUALIFICATIONS**

#### <u>Division 01 – General Requirements and General Conditions</u>

- 1. SpawGlass general requirements assume a 12 month project construction schedule.
- 2. SpawGlass general conditions are included in the cost reports under indirect costs.
- 3. Construction photos will be taken on a regular basis by SpawGlass. Digital files will be turned in monthly. Aerial photos are not included and assumed to be by owner.
- 4. As-Built drawings, record drawings and record submittals will be kept in electronic format. These files will be accessible to all on the jobsite.
- 5. Reasonable repairs or damage caused by unknown factors will be funded from the CM Contingency, if funds remain AND approved by Owner.
- 6. Dimensional Control for the Project is included.
- 7. Individual non-photographic hard hat stickers for workers will be utilized.
- 8. On-site construction facilities have been included in this proposal.
- 9. Temporary barriers and enclosures are included to delineate construction zone from the public.
- 10. Construction cleaning and waste management have been included.
- 11. City fees related to tree mitigation to be by Owner.
- 12. No sound/vibration monitoring included.
- 13. Dust control included in GR's.
- 14. No arborist included, city to use their own arborist. This city arborist includes tree trimming for construction activities and monthly reports that will be provided to SpawGlass on the tree health.

#### **Division 02 - Existing Conditions**

- 1. The extent of demolition includes removal of playground, flatwork, fencing, restrooms, asphalt, concrete, etc. as shown on the demo plans.
- 2. Tree removal is included. Maintenance and care of existing trees to remain by Owner.

#### **Division 03 - Concrete**

- 1. All structural and site concrete is included as shown on the contract drawings.
- 2. Exposed concrete to be Class A finish. Non-exposed concrete to be Class C finish.
- 3. Temporary casing of piers is included at Pavilion. An allowance of \$50,000 is included for temporary casing of piers at Stage.
- 4. Piers at Stage are assumed to be 26', but without competent limestone bearing strata shown in the geotechnical report we have included an allowance of \$30,000.
- 5. Pilot holes are not included for piers.





#### **Division 04 - Masonry**

- 1. Cast Stone caps are included at all seat walls in lieu of limestone cap as shown on Sheet H7.
- 2. Veneer is included as gray leuders random gray ashlar. If limestone can be provided to match existing veneer at Yonder's point, alternate pricing will be provided.
- 3. Standard quadrovent weeps at stone veneer in lieu of stainless weeps and/or aluminum vents as referenced in the drawings and specifications.

Wood blocking included.

#### **Division 07 – Thermal and Moisture Protection**

- 1. Assumed sidewalks require expansion (40' OC) and control joints (10' OC) as outlined on Civil drawings.
- 2. Insulation is included at Restroom roof only.
- 3. Includes manufacturers standard color finish on standing seam metal roof.
- 4. Includes manufacturers standard color finish on metal downspouts and gutters.
- 5. Includes cast iron downspout boots, no finish.
- 6. Water repellant/damp proofing on CMU and veneer walls is not included.

#### **Division 08 - Openings**

1. An allowance of \$10,000 has been included for electrified door hardware at the restrooms. All other hardware assumed to be a hard key.

#### <u>Division 09 - Finishes</u>

- 1. Includes painting of steel structures as shown.
- 2. Includes painting of steel bollards, dumpster gates and railings.
- 3. Level 5 Finish is not included.
- 4. Painting of roof deck above ceiling grid is not included.

#### **Division 10 - Specialties**

1. Includes Hadrian Overhead Braced solid plastic toilet partitions and screens, in manufacturers standard finish.

- 4. Test and Balance is included.

#### **Division 26 - Electrical**

- 1. The transformer and conductors to transformer and from transformer to meter by Oncor.
- Generator is to be provided by City.

#### **Division 27 - Communications**

1. No conductors or equipment have been included, to be provided by City.

#### **Division 28 - Electronic Safety & Security**

- 1. No security included.
- 2. No fire alarm included.





#### **Division 31 - Earthwork**

- 1. All fill under buildings to be low-PI onsite select fill.
- 2. Geo-Grid is included underneath all special sidewalks in lieu of select fill or flexible base as allowed by SCI Engineering Lakeview Geotechnical Addendum Letter, 6/27/2024.
- 3. SWPPP measures as shown are included.
- 4. SpawGlass assumes that all water can be taken from existing City of Round Rock water utilities on-site, and no water will need to be trucked in from other cities due to water restrictions.

#### <u>Division 32 - Exterior Improvements</u>

- 1. Includes mill and overlay of existing parking area.
- 2. Includes site paving as shown.
- 3. Included foundations for butter block walls where taller than 2' (greater than one course).
- 4. Trees are assumed to be provided and delivered to the site by City of Round Rock.
- 5. Includes delivery by subcontractor from CoRR yard and install of mulch, furnished by City of Round Rock.

# **Long Lead Time Equipment and Material**

Currently we believe that the electrical gear is the only long lead time.

### **Construction Document Packages**

It is tentatively anticipated that multiple packages will not be required to satisfy material procurement and drawing development.

### **Proposal Package Strategy**

The project will be advertised for proposals from suppliers, subcontractors, and vendors for all major features of work. Proposals shall be received via mail, email, courier, or hand delivered from subcontractors and suppliers. Any addendums that may be required will be issued one week prior to receiving proposals.

The respondents will be evaluated on the subcontractors' ability to perform the work. Subcontractors will be recommended based on their company's personnel and corporate qualifications. SpawGlass will recommend the best value supplier and/or subcontractor to the Owner for concurrence prior to negotiating their contract.





### **Self-Perform Work**
