WHEREAS, Zoning and Development Code, Chapter 8, Article III, Sec. 8.18, Code of Ordinances (2018 Edition), designates certain trees in the City as Monarch Trees, and

WHEREAS, Monarch Trees are protected and may not be removed unless the monarch designation is removed by the City Council, and

WHEREAS, Jonathan Loiselle has submitted a request on behalf of Stantec to remove the monarch designation for seven trees located on the proposed site of the C.D. Fulkes Middle School Rebuild, as described on Exhibit “A”, Now Therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROUND ROCK, TEXAS,

That the monarch designation for the seven trees numbered 703, 718, 721, 742, 744, 820, and 821 located on the proposed site of the C.D. Fulkes Middle School Rebuild, as described on Exhibit “A”, is hereby removed.

The City Council hereby finds and declares that written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted was posted and that such meeting was open to the public as required by law at all times during which this Resolution and the subject matter hereof were discussed, considered and formally acted upon, all as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended.
