

RESOLUTION NO. R-2026-187

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration (“FTA”) has grant funds available for FY 2026 Section 5307 funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Round Rock (“City”) is seeking funding from FTA’s FY 2026 Section 5307 for the City’s public transit services projects; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to make application for the available FTA FY 2026 Section 5307 funds; and

WHEREAS, the City Council designates the City Manager as the City’s authorized official with power to apply for the grant, including making online application, on behalf of the applicant agency, the City of Round Rock, Texas, Now Therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROUND ROCK, TEXAS,

A. That the City Council approves submission of the grant application to the Federal Transit Administration for the City’s public transit services projects including fixed route bus system and on-demand services.

B. That the City Manager is designated as the authorized official to apply for the grant, including making an online application, and is hereby directed to apply for FY 2026 Federal Transit Authority Section 5307 funding.
