

RESOLUTION NO. R-2026-172

WHEREAS, the City of Round Rock (“City”) and R&R Mobile Joint Venture (“R&R”) previously entered into that certain Wholesale Water Supply and Wastewater Collection and Treatment Agreement (the “Original Agreement”), effective January 27, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the City and R&R entered into that certain Amended and Restated Wholesale Water Supply and Wastewater Collection and Treatment Agreement (the “Amended Agreement”), effective August 8, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Amended Agreement provides that R&R may request to purchase additional Service Units from the City for water and wastewater service; and

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2019, the City and R&R entered into a First Amendment to the Amended Agreement to purchase one additional Service Unit; and

WHEREAS, R&R has requested to purchase three additional Service Units; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to grant R&R’s request and enter into a Second Amendment to the Amended Agreement with R&R, Now Therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROUND ROCK, TEXAS,

That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City, Second Amendment to the Amended and Restated Wholesale Water Supply and Wastewater Collection and Treatment Agreement with R&R Mobile Joint Venture, a copy being attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein for all purposes.

The City Council hereby finds and declares that written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted was posted and that such meeting was open to the public as required by law at all times during which this Resolution and the subject matter hereof were discussed, considered and formally acted upon, all as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended.
