31 32	Temporary food establishment means a food establishment that operates for a period of no more than 14 consecutive days in conjunction with a special single event or celebration. that:			
33 34	(1) Operates for more than four hours in a single day, serves potentially hazardous foods, and is open to the general public; or			
35	(2) Operates for a period of no less than two consecutive days and no more than 14 days.
