23 24 25	(3) The provisions of this chapter 30 shall not be enforced in that portion of the city's extraterritorial jurisdiction that is located in the Brushy Creek Municipal Utility District and that is also located more than 150 feet from the public right-of-way of RM Highway 620 or FM 1431.
