## **RESOLUTION NO. R-2018-5119**

WHEREAS, a group of citizens presented a petition to the City Council requesting that the Round Rock Sports Center be named in honor of former Mayor Alan McGraw; and

**WHEREAS**, the citizens' petition was submitted to a committee consisting of the City Manager and three council members appointed by the Mayor in compliance with the city's policy for naming city facilities; and

WHEREAS, the committee researched, reviewed, and studied the request and has recommended that the petition be approved; and

**WHEREAS**, Alan served as a Council Member from 2001 to 2008, and as Mayor from 2008 to 2017; and

WHEREAS, Alan was instrumental in solidifying Round Rock's position as the "Sports Capital of Texas"; and

WHEREAS, under Alan's leadership, the Round Rock Sports Center on Chisholm Trail and the Round Rock Multipurpose Complex at Old Settlers Park were envisioned, designed, and constructed; and

**WHEREAS,** the Round Rock Sports Center is located on a parcel of land that will include a complex of several other facilities in the future related to sports; and

WHEREAS, future generations will benefit from the lasting legacy of Alan's leadership and efforts; and

**WHEREAS**, in recognition of Alan's service to the community, it is both fitting and proper to name the complex in his honor; Now Therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROUND ROCK, TEXAS,

That the complex which currently includes the Round Rock Sports Center and will include other sports related facilities in the future, is hereby officially named the "Alan McGraw Sports

Complex."
