

**RESOLUTION NO. R-2018-5986**

**WHEREAS**, on June 22, 2017, the City Council approved a contract with Lone Star Paving for the 2017 Street Maintenance Program Chip Seal Project, which included University Boulevard between A.W. Grimes and County Road 110, and

**WHEREAS**, during the re-paving of University Boulevard, certain serious failures were discovered, and

**WHEREAS**, the cost of repairing these failures exceeds the maximum amount allowed by state law for a change order, and

**WHEREAS**, said failures have an adverse impact on the public health and safety of the City's residents, and

**WHEREAS**, Lone Star Paving has submitted a proposal to repair said failures, and

**WHEREAS**, because of the foregoing facts, it is not necessary for the City to comply with the competitive bidding requirements of the Local Government Code, Now Therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROUND ROCK, TEXAS,**

That the City Council hereby determines that the repairs necessitated by the failures discovered in University Boulevard are necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the City's residents, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**

That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City, an amendment to the 2017 Street Maintenance Program Chip Seal Project with Lone Star Paving to repair the aforesaid failures for \$192,000.00.

The City Council hereby finds and declares that written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted was posted and that such meeting was open to the public as required by law at all times during which this Resolution and the subject matter

hereof were discussed, considered and formally acted upon, all as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended.
