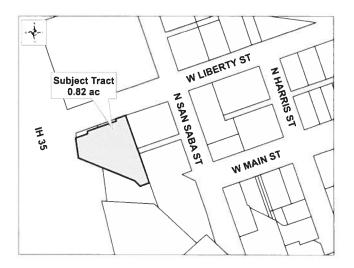

Olson Subdivision Replat of Lot 1 Block A FINAL PLAT FP2008-001

HISTORY: On December 22, 1997, the Planning & Zoning Commission approved the Olson Subdivision (Replat) (Doc No. 9803085, Cabinet P, Slide 176). This replat request will add previously unplatted acreage (west of lot) to the platted lot and create one 0.82-acre lot and accommodate an expansion to an existing place of worship.

DATE OF REVIEW: September 2, 2020

LOCATION: Southwest of the intersection of W. Liberty Street and N. San Saba Street

STAFF REVIEW AND ANALYSIS:

Comprehensive Plan and Zoning: The Comprehensive Plan designates the tract for Downtown Mixed Use. There are two zoning districts on this tract. The eastern portion of the tract is zoned MU-2 (Mixed-Use Downtown Medium Density). The MU-2 zoning district allows places of worship, townhomes, apartments, single-family detached residences, bed and breakfast, offices, and cosmetic services by right. The western portion of the property is zoned C-2 (Local Commercial). The C-2 district allows places of worship and public safety facilities by right.

<u>Traffic, Access and Roads</u>: The subject tract has access from West Liberty Avenue. A hammerhead/turnaround at the western terminus of West Liberty Avenue will remain as a Fire Department lane/turnaround and no additional access to the site is anticipated at this time. A Traffic Impact Analysis (TIA) was deemed not necessary as the development does not meet the a.m. and p.m. peak hour trip threshold to require a TIA.

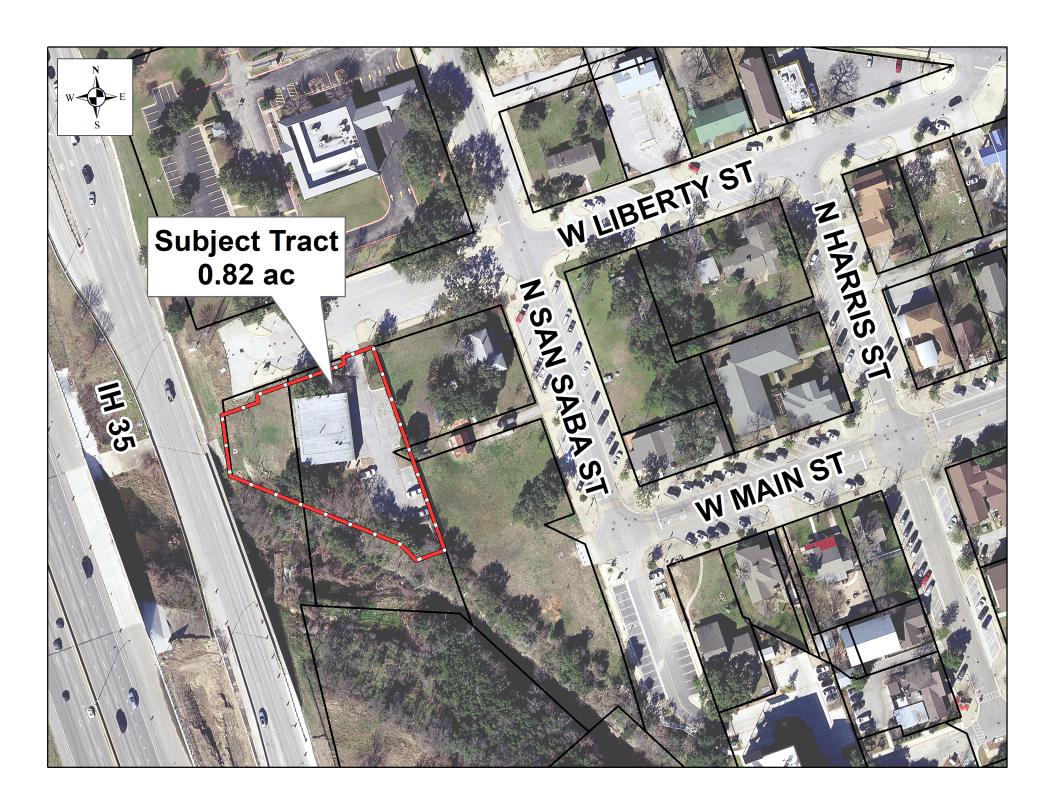
<u>Water and Wastewater Service</u>: Water and wastewater service will be provided by the City of Round Rock. The property is already connected to an existing 12-inch water line located along West Liberty Avenue. Wastewater is already connected to an existing 8-inch wastewater line located along West Liberty Avenue.

<u>Drainage</u>: Development on the subject tract anticipates participation in the City's Regional Storm Water Management Program.

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Staff recommends approval with the following conditions:

- 1. Remove depiction of FEMA (Federal Emergency Management Agency) Floodplain since there is no floodplain on-site.
- Prior to plat recordation, provide clarification for proposed 15' Public Utility Easements (PUE's) on all
 property sides. Confirm if any franchise utilities are within these proposed PUE's. Remove the PUE's If
 no franchise utilities are present.
- 3. A survey tie across each adjacent street or right-of-way to determine right-of-way width(s), with one end of each tie on the subject property boundary, and the other end intersecting with and perpendicular to the opposing right-of-way line.
- 4. Label all right-of-way widths; include complete curve and line data, if applicable.
- 5. Provide a note that all slab elevations shall be a minimum of two (2) feet above the ultimate 1% annual chance floodplain.
- 6. Revise the name of the plat under the owner's signature block to match the official plat name.

Thence, departing the southeast right-of-way line of West Liberty Avenue, with the southwest line of Lot 6, Block 27, Round Rock, the southwest line of that certain alley way as shown in Cobinet A, Slides 190-191, Plat Records, Williamson County, Texas and the southwest line of that certain 1.04 acre tract designated as "TRACT TWO" and recorded in Volume 643, Pages 554-556, Official Public Records, Williamson County, Texas, South 19 degrees 23 minutes 04 seconds East, a distance of 256.21 feet to a 1/2" steel rod found for the southeast corner of the herein described tract, the northeast corner of a 0.350 acre tract recorded in Document No. 2011024295, Official Public Records, Williamson County, Texas;

South 70 degrees 22 minutes 38 seconds West, a distance of 35.62 feet to a 1/2" steel rod found for angle,

North 45 degrees 19 minutes 39 seconds West, a distance of 27.33 feet to a $\frac{1}{2}$ " steel rod found for angle,

and. North 68 degrees 07 minutes 49 seconds West, a distance of 217.49 feet to a 16" steel rod set with an orange "RPLS 5207" plastic cap in the northeast right-of-way line of Interstate Highway 35 for the southwest corner of the herein described tract;

Thence, with the northeast right-of-way line of Interstate Highway 35, North 07 degrees 48 minutes 42 seconds West, a distance of 73.24 feet to a ½" steel rod set with an orange "RPLS 5207" plastic cap for the northwest corner of the herein described tract, a corner of the aforementioned West Liberty Avenue;

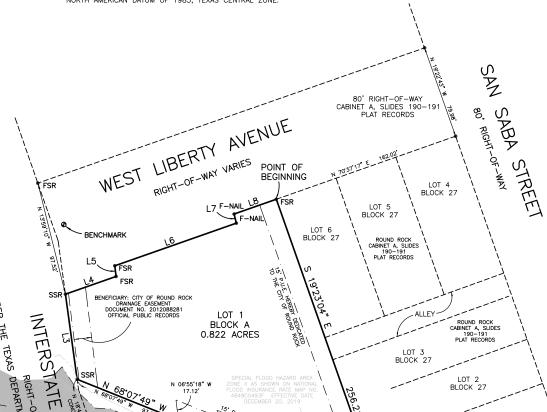
