14	That the "City of Round Rock Design and Construction Standards - Utilities
15	Criteria Manual," Section 1 entitled "Water, Reuse Water, and Wastewater," is hereby
16	amended to add Subsection 1.4.2 "City Acceptance," which shall read as follows:
17	1.4.2. City Acceptance

Prior to City acceptance of new public utilities, the utility as-built plans must be submitted electronically. They must be submitted electronically in shapefile format (projectname utilschem.shp). The file shall be georeferenced to the State Plane Grid Coordinate System – Texas Central zone (4203) or may be in surface coordinates provided it contains a minimum of two (2) survey points referenced to the City of Round Rock Control Network and be labeled in US feet. It must also include rotation information and the scale factor required to convert the surface coordinates to grid coordinates.
27 28 29 30	Other electronic versions of the utility as-built plans may be accepted but only with express approval from the Utilities and Environmental Services Department. PDF, JPEG, TIF, or other types of image files will not be accepted. This requirement is in addition to the submittal of the sealed Record Drawings.
31 32 33	<b>II.</b> That the "City of Round Rock Design and Construction Standards - Utilities
34	Criteria Manual," Section 1 entitled "Water, Reuse Water, and Wastewater," subsection
35	1.6.2.B.19 "Water Systems," is hereby amended to read as follows:
36 37 38 39	19. Wherever possible, a looped water system shall be provided and dead- end mains will be avoided. When a dead-end main containing more than 100 gallons of water is proposed, it must be approved by the City and meet the following criteria:

1 2 3	A	If a dead-end section is installed and no service is to be taken from the dead-end main, an approved flushing assembly device must be installed at the terminus of the dead-end main.
4 5 6 7	₿	If a dead-end section is installed and service is to be provided via the dead-end, the water demand from the dead-end section must be sufficient to turn over the water at least every 72 hours.
8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16		If the water demand is not sufficient to turn over the water every 72 hours, an approved flushing assembly device must be installed at the terminus of the dead end main. Looped water systems must be provided, and dead-end water mains must be avoided. Should a looped water system be deemed not possible, a variance must be obtained from the Utilities and Environmental Services Department to allow any new or proposed dead-end water main.
17 18 19		All dead-end water mains must have an approved flushing assembly device installed at the terminus of the dead-end main.
