

## **RESOLUTION NO. R-2021-158**

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (“TCEQ”) has grant funds available through the Governmental Alternative Fuel Fleet Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Round Rock (“City”) is seeking grant funding to supplement the purchase of electric vehicles for the City’s fleet and the infrastructure to support said vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to make application for the available Governmental Alternative Fuel Fleet Grant Program funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council designates the City Manager as the City’s authorized official with power to apply for the grant, including making online application, on behalf of the applicant agency, the City of Round Rock, Texas, Now Therefore

### **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROUND ROCK, TEXAS,**

A. That the City Council approves submission of the grant application to the TCEQ for the Governmental Alternative Fuel Fleet Grant Program.

B. That the City Manager is designated as the authorized official to apply for the grant, including making an online application, and is hereby directed to apply to TCEQ for Governmental Alternative Fuel Fleet Grant Program funding.
