CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATENESS:

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E.1 Consider a Certificate of Appropriateness for alterations including a new roof at 802 E. Liberty Ave

Principal Planner Joelle Jordan made the staff presentation regarding a new standing seam metal roof on the house, guest house, and garage at 802 E. Liberty Avenue. Because the original roof material is unknown and standing seam metal was a commonly available option when the house was built, and because the roof is not a prominent feature of the house, staff did not believe that the roof material is a "distinctive or character-defining feature" of the house and found that the proposal did not violate the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Preservation #3 and 4 or Standards for Rehabilitation #4 and 5.

A motion was made by Commissioner Wolfe and seconded by Commissioner Parson to approve the Certificate of Appropriateness for a new roof at 802 E. Liberty Avenue, using the requested metal roof in Matte Black or Charcoal Gray, with the condition that no alterations are made to the architecture or structure of the house, and allowing staff to review any necessary modifications.
