16	pursuant to an engineering and traffic investigation, and
17	WHEREAS, an engineering and traffic investigation was conducted on a portion
18	of Creek Bend Boulevard (both directions) beginning at Wyoming Springs Drive to the
19	southern approach to Brushy Creek Bridge, and
20	WHEREAS, a copy of said engineering and traffic study is attached hereto and
21	incorporated herein for all purposes as Exhibit "A", and
22	WHEREAS, the results of said engineering and traffic investigation indicate that
23	the speed zone on Creek Bend Boulevard (both directions) beginning at Wyoming
24	Springs Drive to the southern approach to Brushy Creek Bridge, should be amended,
25	Now Therefore
