Consider a resolution authorizing the Texas Housing Foundation to exercise its powers in the City of Round Rock and authorizing the Mayor to execute a Cooperation Agreement regarding the Round Rock Oakgrove Apartments.

City Related Affordable is requesting a resolution of support for their application for funding from the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs. This Cooperation Agreement allows the Texas Housing Foundation to finance, plan and operate a housing project in Round Rock for the benefit of lower income residents of the City. They are seeking to purchase and renovate an existing incomerestricted apartment complex located at 900 Westwood Drive, which is just east of Lake Creek Drive. The project is proposed to be financed, in part, by equity generated from low-income housing tax credits issued by the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs. The agreement includes a payment in lieu of tax agreement.

The Round Rock Oak Grove Apartments contains 24 one-story units, all of which currently have restricted rents, which will be continued if the funding is awarded. The property is zoned MF-2 (Multifamily - Medium Density), which permits apartments. The Round Rock Housing Authority's one story apartment units are located to the west, single family and duplexes to the south, and a private school to the north and east.
