Consider a resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute a Contract for Engineering Services with Halff Associates, Inc. for the Wyoming Springs Segment 1 Project.

This contract with Halff, Associates, Inc. is for the development of a final schematic, environmental clearance, preparation of Right-of-Way documents, performance of utility coordination and development of 30% construction Plans, Specifications and Engineering (PS&E) documents for the ultimate construction of a new 4 lane divided arterial roadway with off-street shared paths, Wyoming Springs Boulevard Segment 1. This new roadway will connect the existing Wyoming Springs Blvd at its' intersection with Creek Bend Blvd/Brightwater Blvd. to the intersection with FM 3406/Old Settlers Blvd. This segment of roadway is being proposed as a stand alone project but is part of a multisegment multi-phase vision to construct/upgrade Wyoming Springs Blvd from RM 620 to Arterial H (E. New Hope Dr.).

The Wyoming Springs Blvd. corridor is an important north/south transportation artery in Round Rock. This arterial roadway has been identified in the city's 2017 Transportation Master Plan as a corridor that needs to be completed to ensure reduced congestion and travel times while increasing safety. The Transportation Master Plan has determined the ultimate section for this roadway to be a 4-lane divided urban arterial with off-street shared use paths. This roadway section will provide increased mobility as well as enhanced driver/pedestrian safety. Mobility is increased by the connection of two previously completed sections of Wyoming Springs Blvd. and by adding turn lanes at these two major intersections. Safety is enhanced by inclusion of a raised median to direct turning traffic movement to controlled intersections and by the inclusion of the shared use paths for pedestrians and bicyclists.

This contract will take the concept developed in the 2017 Transportation Master Plan and move that approach forward from the study stage to preliminary engineering, environmental clearance and PS&E preparation up to the 30% complete status. The project will be re-evaluated at completion of this contract and moved forward under future contracts as funding allows and as directed by the council.
